STARR COUNTY INSTALLS SOLAR STREET LIGHTS

Akari Energy Installs Off-Grid Solar Energy

Rio Grande City, TX (January 19, 2011) –The Starr County Transfer Station is now illuminated using off-grid solar-powered street lighting. Starr County hired Akari Energy to bring green energy to the new facility. A total of 3.24 kilowatts (kW) was placed in service at the site on December 29, 2010, and will save taxpayers money they would have had to pay for trenching to each street light. Also, since the street lights are 100% solar-powered, the electricity is free.
